Our History and Mission

"To advocate for and provide the resources, skills, and shelter to alleviate abuse through prevention and intervention for all children and their families."

Manatee Children's Services was founded in 1977 by Carol Chamberlain: a librarian, teacher, and social worker with a passion for child advocacy. Through her work in social services, Carol learned that Manatee County had a dire need for shelter to house abused children removed from their homes. She rallied a group of citizens to make the shelter a reality and, to this day, MCS continues to operate as Manatee County's only emergency shelter for child victims of abuse and the county's only Child Advocacy Center.

We provide a full spectrum of programs serving over 12,000 children and families annually. We offer programs in treatment, prevention, intervention, and residential services. Such programs include an emergency shelter,

long-term group homes, mental health services, parenting education and training, forensic medical and specialized child victim interview services, support services for relative caregivers, teen pregnancy prevention, and children's personal safety. Visit our <u>website</u> to learn more.

MCS Receives Bradenton Police Department's 2022 Florida Contraband Forfeiture Fund Award Program

We at MCS are so proud to have been selected as one of ten organizations awarded with Bradenton Police Department's 2022 Florida Contraband Forfeiture Fund Award Program. This generous award of \$4,500 will support new curriculum materials to educate teens on substance use, "Darkness to Light" training for child sexual abuse prevention, and substance use screening tools for foster children.

Chief of Police Melanie Bevan awarded all ten organizations a total of more than \$30,000 in funding at the Bradenton City Council meeting on October 14, 2022.

The purpose of this program is to provide support to neighborhood agencies and organizations engaged in projects that seek to improve neighborhood safety, promote crime prevention, drug prevention, drug education, drug treatment services, or school resource officer programs. This goal is accomplished by funding neighborhood groups, associations, or organizations which have developed specific projects to address these areas of concern. The program is a highlight of Bradenton Police Department's unofficial motto, "One City, One Team," fostering relationships and investing in the future of our community.

The 2022 recipients included Boys & Girls Club of Manatee County, Inc., Bradenton Gladiators Football, Inc., Bradenton Police Department Explorer Post #1004, Drug Free Manatee, Making an Impact, Manatee Children's Services, Inc., Manatee County Girls Club, Inc. dba Just for Girls, New Manatee Broncos, Pace Center for Girls, and Replay Outreach, Inc.
