#### Our History and Mission

"To advocate for and provide the resources, skills, and shelter to alleviate abuse through prevention and intervention for all children and their families."

Manatee Children's Services was founded in 1977 by Carol Chamberlain: a librarian, teacher, and social worker with a passion for child advocacy. Through her work in social services, Carol learned that Manatee County had a dire need for shelter to house abused children removed from their homes. She rallied a group of citizens to make the shelter a reality and, to this day, MCS continues to operate as Manatee County's only emergency shelter for child victims of abuse and the county's only Child Advocacy Center.

We provide a full spectrum of programs serving over 12,000 children and families annually. We offer programs in treatment, prevention, intervention, and residential services. Such programs include an emergency shelter, long-term group homes, mental health services, parenting education and training, forensic medical and specialized child victim interview services, support services for relative caregivers, teen pregnancy prevention, and children's personal safety. # MCS PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



We recognized the month of May as National Foster Care Month, a time to increase national awareness of foster care issues and recognize the important role that people from all parts of child welfare play in supporting children, youth, and families.

An integral component to foster care support is kinship care with relatives and close friends. Kinship care placements have increased from 14% in 2006 to 22% in 2021. These placements can increase stability, reduce trauma, and help children maintain cultural connections and a sense of belonging by keeping them out of foster care and with a trusted support system.

Our "Grandparents as Parents" Family Advocates understand the importance of kinship care as well as the challenges associated with parenting a second time around and offer advocacy, resources, and support to caregivers. Two particular caregivers in our program had been raising their grandchild after removal from the parents due to substance use and were ready for adoption. Our staff helped them set up a lawyer and gain a village of support from other kinship caregivers in the program. We are grateful for all the hardworking caregivers in our program who work tirelessly to raise the children in their care and keep their families together and the staff who empower them to do so.
