Our Mission and Programs

"To advocate for and provide the resources, skills, and shelter to alleviate abuse through prevention and intervention for all children and their families."

Manatee Children's Services was founded in 1977 by Carol Chamberlain: a librarian, teacher, and social worker with a passion for child advocacy. Through her work in social services, Carol learned that Manatee County had a dire need for shelter to house abused children removed from their homes. She rallied a group of citizens to make the shelter a reality and, to this day, MCS continues to operate as Manatee County's only emergency shelter for child victims of abuse and the county's only Child Advocacy Center.

We provide a full spectrum of programs serving over 12,000 children and families annually. We offer programs in treatment, prevention, intervention, and residential services. Such programs include an emergency shelter, long-term group homes, mental health services, parenting education and training, forensic medical and specialized child victim interview services, support services for relative caregivers, teen pregnancy prevention, and children's personal safety. ABOUT CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH



Since 1983, April has been recognized as National Child Abuse Prevention Month: a time to raise awareness and promote efforts to prevent child abuse. This month continues to serve as an annual reminder about the importance of prevention, supporting families, and raising awareness about the signs of child abuse and neglect.

A report of child abuse is made every 10 seconds in the U.S., with an estimated 558,899 confirmed victims annually — 8 children per 1,000. In Manatee County, 5,301 reports are filed yearly at a rate higher than the state average, leading to approximately 707 confirmed cases. Around 600 of these children are referred to the MCS Child Protection Team for medical exams and forensic interviews to assess abuse and determine safety measures. Infants and toddlers make up a significant portion of victims. Additionally, marginalized groups, including BIPOC, disabled, and LGBTQ youth, face higher victimization rates. Child abuse leads to long-term social, academic, and health challenges, with nearly 1,990 child fatalities annually. Since most abuse is committed by parents or guardians, prevention efforts focus on strengthening caregiver support networks and providing parenting programs to reduce stress and enhance nurturing environments.

Our prevention teams include KIDS Personal Safety to teach elementary schoolchildren how to identify and report abuse, TRUTH for adolescents to learn healthy relationships and personal safety, GAP to support relative caregivers, and BRIC/FPRP to teach at-risk parents how to become nurturing caregivers. These teams work vigilantly every day in the fight against child abuse, which is evident in our success rates; approximately 98% of children and families served in our prevention programs achieve successes that are shown to prevent future abuse, reduce repeat instances of abuse, and keep families stable. We are so grateful to our prevention teams for carrying out the mission of MCS.
